BY-LAW No. 531-2004

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 363, Building Construction and Demolition, Article I, Building Permits, to establish a fee for demolition permit applications requiring an environmental review.

WHEREAS section 7 of the *Building Code Act, 1992*, authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws concerning the issuance of permits and related matters including the payment of fees; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 163-1998 “A By-law under the *Building Code Act, 1992* respecting permits and related matters.” is now Article I, Building Permits, of Chapter 363, Building Construction and Demolition, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 3C, Demolition, of Schedule A to Chapter 363, Building Construction and Demolition, Article I, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following in alphabetical order by building classification:

2. This by-law comes into force on July 5, 2004.
