BY-LAW No. 548-2004

To define the North Rosedale Area as an area of the City of Toronto to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district.

WHEREAS section 40 of the *Ontario Heritage Act* authorizes the council of a municipality to enact by-laws to define one or more areas thereof as an area to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

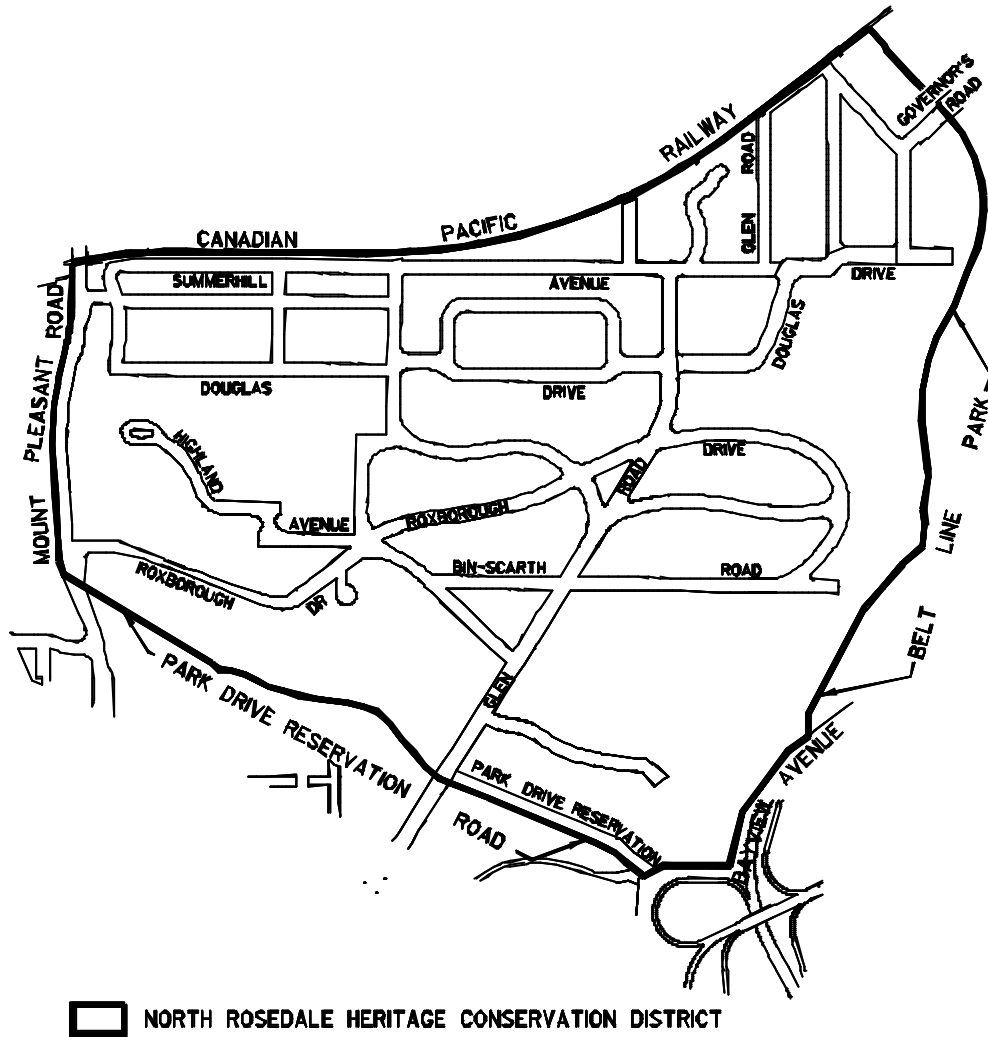
