BY-LAW No. 556-2004

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees, to establish charges for the application of a permit to construct a swimming pool enclosure and for an exemption from the provisions of Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences.

WHEREAS under section 391 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; and

WHEREAS the application for an exemption to the requirements of Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, which includes the on site attendance of a by-law enforcement officer of the Municipal Licensing and Standards Division, and the review of an application for a permit to construct a swimming pool enclosure, are services or activities provided by the City of Toronto;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 441, Fees, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following section:

§ 441-15. Applications under Chapter 447, Fences.

- A. Fees.
- (1) The application fee payable under § 441-3B(3)(c) for a permit to construct a swimming pool enclosure is \$84.00.
- (2) The application fee payable for an exemption from the provisions of Chapter 447, Fences is \$200.00.
- B. The charges established in Subsection A do not include taxes, and any applicable taxes shall be added to the charge.
