BY-LAW No. 598-2004

To permanently close portions of the public highways Neilson Road and Staines Road.

WHEREAS it is recommended that portions of the public highways Neilson Road and Staines Road be permanently closed as public highways and be sold upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 16 of Toronto East Community Council Report No. 5, as adopted by City Council at its meeting held on June 22, 23 and 24, 2004; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portions of highways was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and no one appeared to address the Scarborough Community Council at its meeting held on July 6, 2004;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portions of the public highways Neilson Road and Staines Road, described as follows, are hereby permanently closed as public highways:

FIRSTLY: (Part of Neilson Road).

Part of PIN 06053-0014 (LT).

Part of the Road Allowance between Lots 14 and 15 in Concession 4, Scarborough, designated as PARTS 4, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 on Plan 66R-21113, being part of Neilson Road in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in City of Toronto (formerly the City of Scarborough).

SECONDLY: (Part of Staines Road).

Part of PIN 06053-0038 (LT).

Part of the Road Allowance between Lots 12 and 13 in Concession 4, Scarborough, designated as PARTS 18 and 20 on Plan 66R-19462, being part of Staines Road in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of Scarborough).
