BY-LAW No. 601-2004

To amend By-law No. 2958-94 of the former City of York, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”, regarding Belgravia Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

NO STOPPING - SCHEDULE IX

1. That Schedule IX of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u>
Belgravia Avenue	South	Dufferin Street and a point 61 metres east thereof	Anytime

NO STOPPING - SCHEDULE IX

2. That Schedule IX of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Prohibited</u> <u>Times or Days</u>
Belgravia Avenue	South	Dufferin Street and a point 69 metres east thereof	Anytime
