BY-LAW No. 610-2004

**To permanently close a portion of Kenaston Gardens, shown as Parts 2 and 3 on
Reference Plan 66R-20940.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public highway, Kenaston Gardens, located east of Bayview Avenue and extending southerly from Sheppard Avenue East, shown as Parts 2 and 3 on Plan 66R-20940 be permanently closed as a public highway and be sold to Daniels Kenaston North Corporation, upon the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 2 of the Toronto North Community Council Report No. 38 as adopted by Council at its meeting held on March 1, 2 and 3, 2004; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said portion of the public highway was posted on the Public Notices page of the City's internet web site for at least the two week period immediately preceding the Toronto North Community Council meeting held on April 7, 2004. No one appeared to address the Toronto North Community Council;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of the public highway, Kenaston Gardens, legally described as follows:

Part of PIN 10090-0313(LT).

Being that Part of the Public Highway, Kenaston Gardens, described as all of Block A and Part of Block B, Plan 4397 and designated as Parts 2 and 3 on Plan 66R-20940 registered in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Land Registry Office (No. 66), City of Toronto is hereby permanently closed as a public highway.
