BY-LAW No. 639-2004

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Cosburn Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of East York By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Cosburn Avenue	Both	Donlands Avenue and a point approximately 91.5 metres west	Anytime

- 2. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of East York By-law No. 92-93, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

(From Column 1 Road)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and Days)
Cosburn Avenue	North	Broadview Avenue and Woodbine Avenue	7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Monday to Friday inclusive

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
