BY-LAW No. 643-2004

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding Lea Avenue and Leacrest Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of East York By-law No. 92-93, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

Leacrest Road	North	The easterly limit of Mallory Crescent (east leg) and the westerly limit of Rolph Road	Anytime
