BY-LAW No. 665-2004

To authorize the alteration of Winona Drive, between Falwyn Avenue and Glenhurst Avenue, by the installation of speed humps and the narrowing of the northbound approach of the Winona Drive and Dundurn Crescent intersection by the placement of a planter box.

WHEREAS a speed hump poll of households on Winona Drive, between Falwyn Avenue and Glenhurst Avenue, was conducted and as the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto South Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Winona Drive;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of speed humps on Winona Drive, between Falwyn Avenue and Glenhurst Avenue, and the narrowing of the northbound approach of the Winona Drive and Dundurn Crescent intersection by the placement of a planter box, as generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-7228, dated January, 2004, on file in the office of Transportation Services, South District.
