BY-LAW No. 752-2004

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, respecting transfers of standard taxicab owner's licences.

WHEREAS By-law No. 906-2003 was enacted by Toronto City Council on September 24, 2003, to implement Recommendation 14(b) of Clause No. 1 of Emergency and Protective Services Committee Report No. 13, as adopted by City of Toronto Council on November 25, 26 and 27, 1998, that after five years, standard taxicab owner's licences only be transferable to individuals holding a valid taxicab driver's licence; and

WHEREAS staff have discovered a drafting error in By-law No. 906-2003, and as a result of the drafting error, the interaction between Toronto Municipal Code §§ 545-142A(1) and 545-142A(3) may create ambiguity regarding whether standard taxicabs can be transferred to corporations, contrary to Toronto City Council's intention in passing the By-law; and

WHEREAS any ambiguity can be clarified and Toronto City Council's intention more clearly articulated by correcting the drafting error;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Subsection 545-142A(1) of Article VIII of Chapter 545, Licensing, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by deleting the phrase, "Subsection A(3) hereof and to".
- **2.** Chapter 545 is further amended by deleting § 545-142A(3).
- **3.** This By-law is deemed to have come into force on January 1, 2004.
