BY-LAW No. 840-2004

To name the private lane at 3197 Kingston Road “Stobo Lane”.

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from September 7, 2004 to September 13, 2004, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 14, 2004, and it is appropriate to name the private lane at the residential development at 3197 Kingston Road as “Stobo Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The private lane shown on “Attachment No. 1” to this By-law dated February 13, 2004 is named “Stobo Lane”.
2. 1525400 Ontario Inc., its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage.
3. 1525400 Ontario Inc., its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.

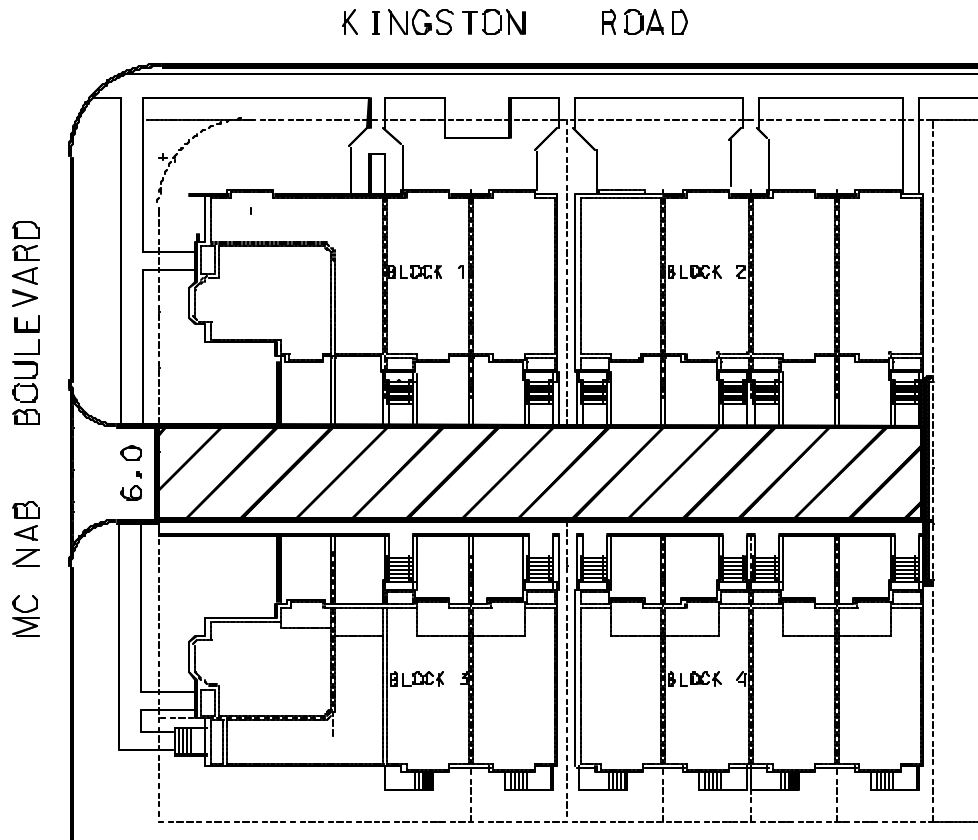

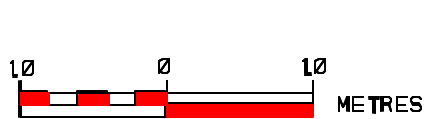
