BY-LAW No. 892-2004

To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 108-86, designating certain locations on former Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers, regarding Albion Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 108-86, being a By-law "To designate certain locations on former Metropolitan Roads as Pedestrian Crossovers", as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

Albion Road	Between north side (westbound Albion Road) and centre refuge
(M.T. 11)	island approximately 230 metres west of Kipling Avenue
Albion Road	Between south side (eastbound Albion Road) and centre refuge
(M.T. 11)	island approximately 230 metres west of Kipling Avenue
