**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 898-2004**

**To amend former North York By-law No. 20953, being a by-law “To prohibit the parking or driving of vehicles on boulevards within the Township of North York”, to eliminate the voluntary payment amount for all parking offences.**

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of May 18, 19 and 20, 2004, directed that the voluntary payment amounts for all parking offences be eliminated; and

WHEREAS it is therefore necessary to amend former City of North York By-law No. 20953, being a by-law “To prohibit the parking or driving of vehicles on boulevards within the Township of North York” to reflect this recommendation;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 20953 of the former City of North York, being a by-law “To prohibit the parking or driving of vehicles on boulevards within the Township of North York”, is amended by repealing subsection 4(3).
