BY-LAW No. 899-2004

To amend former North York By-law No. 30662, being a by-law “To prohibit parking of motor vehicles on all public highways within the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the City of North York”, to eliminate the voluntary payment amount for all parking offences.

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of May 18, 19 and 20, 2004, directed that the voluntary payment amounts for all parking offences be eliminated; and

WHEREAS it is therefore necessary to amend former City of North York By-law No. 30662, being a by-law “To prohibit parking of motor vehicles on all public highways within the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the City of North York” to reflect this recommendation;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 30662 of the former City of North York, being a by-law “To prohibit parking of motor vehicles on all public highways within the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the City of North York”, is amended by repealing subsections 4(c), 4(e), 4(f) and 4(g).
