BY-LAW No. 904-2004

**To amend former Borough of East York By-laws Nos. 34-93, 92-93, 197, 23-89, 1478, 271
and 48-94, to eliminate the voluntary payment amount for all parking offences.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 34-93 of the former Borough of East York, as amended, being a by-law “To provide for disabled person parking permit holders”, is amended by repealing subsection 10(c).
2. By-law No. 92-93 of the former Borough of East York, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, is amended by repealing subsections 50(c), 50(e), 50(f) and 50(g).
3. By-law No. 197 of the former Borough of East York, as amended, being a by-law “To provide for parking meters on roads in the Borough of East York”, is amended by repealing subsections 12(c), 12(e), 12(f), and 12(g).
4. By-law No. 23-89 of the former Borough of East York, as amended, being a by-law “To regulate the use of that part of the public roadway between the curb and the street line”, is amended by repealing subsection 11(c).
5. By-law No. 1478 of the former Borough of East York, as amended, being a by-law “To provide for prohibited parking save by permit”, is amended by repealing subsection 12(3).
6. By-law No. 271 of the former Borough of East York, as amended, being a by-law “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways”, is amended by repealing subsections 7(c), 7(e), 7(f) and 7(g).
7. By-law No. 48-94 of the former Borough of East York, as amended, being a by-law “To licence and regulate boulevard parking in non-residential areas”, is amended by repealing subsection 7.1(c).
