CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 915-2004

To amend former Metropolitan By-law No. 17-87, being a by-law “To prohibit the parking or leaving of motor vehicles on property owned or occupied by The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto or any local board thereof without the consent of the Municipality or local board, as the case may be”, to eliminate the voluntary payment amount for all parking offences.

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of May 18, 19 and 20, 2004, directed that the voluntary payment amounts for all parking offences be eliminated; and

WHEREAS it is therefore necessary to amend former Metropolitan By-law No. 17-87, being a by-law “To prohibit the parking or leaving of motor vehicles on property owned or occupied by The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto or any local board thereof without the consent of the Municipality or local board, as the case may be” to reflect this recommendation;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 17-87 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, being a by-law “To prohibit the parking or leaving of motor vehicles on property owned or occupied by The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto or any local board thereof without the consent of the Municipality or local board, as the case may be”, is amended by repealing subsection 3(3).
