**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 916-2004**

**To amend former Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on Metropolitan Roads”, to eliminate the voluntary payment amount for all parking offences.**

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of May 18, 19 and 20, 2004, directed that the voluntary payment amounts for all parking offences be eliminated; and

WHEREAS it is therefore necessary to amend former Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on Metropolitan Roads” to reflect this recommendation;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 32-92 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on Metropolitan Roads”, is amended by repealing subsections 52(5), 52(6), 52(7), and 52(8).
