BY-LAW No. 919-2004

To amend former Scarborough By-law No. 23503, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on Roads in the City of Scarborough”, to eliminate the voluntary payment amount for all parking offences.

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of May 18, 19 and 20, 2004, directed that the voluntary payment amounts for all parking offences be eliminated; and

WHEREAS it is therefore necessary to amend former Scarborough By-law No. 23503, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on Roads in the City of Scarborough” to reflect this recommendation;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 23503 of the former City of Scarborough, being a by-law “To regulate traffic on Roads in the City of Scarborough”, is amended by repealing subsections 52(5), 52(6), 52(7) and 52(8).
