**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 950-2004**

**To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the  
Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, regarding  
Woodville Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and Days)
Woodville Avenue	South	A point 146 metres east of Pape Avenue and a point 31 metres further east	Anytime

2. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Road)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and Days)
Woodville Avenue	South	Pape Avenue and a point 177 metres east	Anytime

3. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Road)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and Days)
Woodville Avenue	South	Pape Avenue and a point 146 metres east	Anytime
