**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 956-2004**

**To name the proposed private lane at 1379 Bloor Street West as “Merchant Lane”.**

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from September 27, 2004 to October 11, 2004, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on October 12, 2004, and it is appropriate to name the proposed private lane at the residential development at 1379 Bloor Street West as “Merchant Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The proposed private lane shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated February 2, 2004 is named “Merchant Lane”.
2. Lorbeth Developments Corporation, its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage.
3. Lorbeth Developments Corporation, its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.


