## BY-LAW No. 957-2004

To name the private lane system at 2264 Lake Shore Boulevard West as "Yachters Lane".

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from September 27, 2004 to October 11, 2004, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on October 12, 2004, and it is appropriate to name the private lane system at the residential development at 2264 Lake Shore Boulevard West as "Yachters Lane";

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:


- 1. The private lane system shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated May 22, 2003 is named "Yachters Lane".
- 2. Thornridge Homes, its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage.
- 3. Thornridge Homes, its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.


