BY-LAW No. 958-2004

To name the private lane at 2 and 4 Sand Beach Road as “Nautical Lane”.

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from September 27, 2004 to October 11, 2004, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on October 12, 2004, and it is appropriate to name the private lane at the residential development at 2 and 4 Sand Beach Road as “Nautical Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The private lane shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated December 5, 2003 is named “Nautical Lane”.
2. Zanini Developments Inc., its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage.
3. Zanini Developments Inc., its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.
