BY-LAW No. 961-2004

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding William R. Allen Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrians Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
William R. Allen Road Southbound (M.T. 21)	Between a point 30.5 metres south of the south curb line of the Toronto Transit Commission Parking Lot access located approximately 510 metres south of Sheppard Avenue West and a point 30.5 metres north of the north curb line of the Toronto Transit Commission Parking Lot access

- 2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
William R. Allen Road and the Toronto Transit Commission Parking Lot access located approximately 510 metres south of Sheppard Avenue West (M.T. 21)	Northbound	Right	Anytime
William R. Allen Road and the Toronto Transit Commission Parking Lot access located approximately 510 metres south of Sheppard Avenue West (M.T. 21)	Westbound	Left	Anytime
