BY-LAW No. 962-2004

To further amend By-law No. 132-93, respecting reserved lanes for designated classes of vehicles on certain former Metropolitan Roads, regarding William R. Allen Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Schedule I to By-law No. 132-93, being a By-law “To provide reserved lanes for designated classes of vehicles on certain Metropolitan Roads”, as amended, is further amended by deleting the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:
