## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## BY-LAW No. 970-2004

To layout and dedicate certain land on the south side of Ranee Avenue, west of W. R. Allen Road, for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Ranee Avenue.

WHEREAS the City of Toronto is the owner of certain land acquired by the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto in connection with an expropriation for the former proposed Spadina Expressway, and this land was declared surplus by Council in 2003 except for a strip retained for road widening purposes;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land on the south side of Ranee Avenue, west of W. R. Allen Road, described by W. Kowalenko, City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 10229-0011 (LT).

Part of Lot 5 on Plan 4099 and part of Lot 8, Concession 2 WYS, Township of York, designated as PART 1 on Plan 66R-20608 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of North York) and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Ranee Avenue.
