BY-LAW No. 974-2004

To alter Westona Street at its intersection with Braecrest Avenue by the installation of a temporary Jersey barrier (directional diverter) as a traffic calming measure.

WHEREAS Council authorized the installation of the temporary Jersey Barrier (directional diverter) as a traffic calming measure and staff of Works and Emergency Services have undertaken a poll of the affected neighbourhood; and

WHEREAS by notification dated October 22, 2004 from Works and Emergency Services it was confirmed that the poll results were positive and accordingly the temporary Jersey Barrier should be installed;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The alteration of Westona Street at its intersection with Braecrest Avenue by the installation of a temporary Jersey barrier (directional diverter) as a traffic calming measure is authorized.
