BY-LAW No. 986-2004

To define Madison Avenue between Bloor Street West and Dupont Street as an area of the City of Toronto to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district.

WHEREAS section 40 of the *Ontario Heritage Act* authorizes the council of a municipality to enact by-laws to define one or more areas thereof as an area to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The area comprised of all of the properties fronting on both sides of Madison Avenue from Bloor Street West to Dupont Street is defined as an area to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, chapter O.18.
