BY-LAW No. 1071-2004

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 813, Trees, Article III Tree Protection, by deleting the permit fee exemption for senior citizens and providing for a permit fee exemption for owners living below the Low Income Cut Off.

WHEREAS Article III, Tree Protection, Municipal Code Chapter 813, Trees, § 813-26 provides that seniors age 65 and over shall not be required to pay the permit fee; and

WHEREAS at its meeting of October 26, 27 and 28, 2004 Council resolved that the authority of the Commissioner of Economic Development, Culture and Tourism to waive permit application fees for seniors be rescinded and be replaced with the authority to waive permit application fees in cases of hardship;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 813-26 is deleted.
2. Section 813-13 is amended by adding the following:
 - E. To waive the permit application fee for owners living below the Low Income Cut Off as determined by Statistics Canada.
