## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## BY-LAW No. 1076-2004

To amend the General Zoning By-law No. 438-86 of the former City of Toronto with respect to Algonquin and Ward's Islands.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Section 12(2)295(b) of By-law No. 438-86, being "A By-law to regulate the use of land and the erection, use, bulk, height, spacing of and other matters relating to buildings and structures and to prohibit certain uses of lands and the erection and use of certain buildings and structures in various areas of the City of Toronto", as amended, is further amended by adding a new subparagraph (iv) as follows:
  - "(iv) A <u>detached house</u> originally constructed as such may be altered to contain two <u>dwelling units</u> provided the <u>residential gross floor area</u> of the <u>dwelling unit</u> to be created, including any floor area below <u>grade</u>, is less than the <u>residential gross floor area</u> of the remaining <u>dwelling unit</u>."
