BY-LAW No. 1113-2004

To name the proposed private lane at 4691 Bathurst Street, 500 Ellerslie Avenue and 45 to 51 Farrell Avenue as “Flook Lane”.

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from November 5, 2004 to November 15, 2004, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on November 16, 2004, and it is appropriate to name the proposed private lane at the residential development at 4691 Bathurst Street, 500 Ellerslie Avenue and 45 to 51 Farrell Avenue as “Flook Lane”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The proposed private lane shown on Attachment No. 1 to this By-law dated June 9, 2004 is named “Flook Lane”.
2. Aspen Ridge Homes, its agent or successor shall enter into an agreement with the City to pay the City for the costs of fabrication and installation of the appropriate signage.
3. Aspen Ridge Homes, its agent or successor shall maintain, at their own risk, the signage installed under section 2 of this By-law.

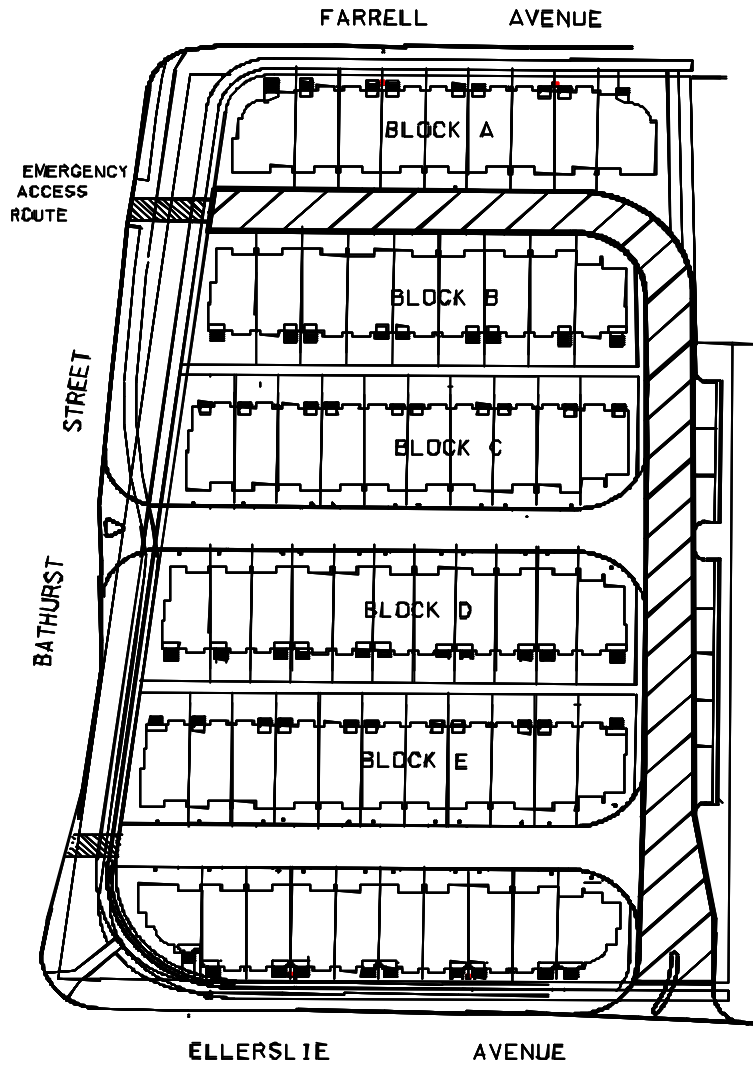

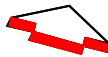
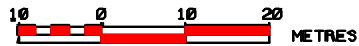
