BY-LAW No. 21-2006

To make a technical amendment to By-law No. 1016-2005, a by-law “To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, respecting the hours of operation of holistic centres and traditional medicine establishments.”

WHEREAS By-law No. 1016-2005, a by-law to amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, respecting the hours of operation of holistic centres and traditional medicine establishments was passed by City Council on December 7, 2005; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 1016-2005 contains a technical numbering error;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 1016-2005 is amended by deleting section 2 thereof and by replacing it with the following:
 2. Chapter 545 is amended by adding the following section:

471.1 No owner shall open his or her traditional medicine establishment for business or permit the same to be or to remain open for business or permit any traditional medicine service or services of any kind to be provided or offered in the traditional medicine establishment at any time except between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.
2. This by-law is deemed to have come into effect on December 7, 2005.
