BY-LAW No. 50-2006

**To amend By-law No. 62-91 respecting reserved lanes for bicycles on certain former
Metropolitan Roads, regarding Dundas Street East.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "A" to By-law No. 62-91, being a By-law "To provide reserved lanes for bicycles on certain Metropolitan Roads", as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
