BY-LAW No. 64-2006

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to permit the retention of a portion of a wooden pool fence on the property municipally known as 29 Bessborough Drive.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 447-5 of Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The existing portion of a wood board-on-board pool fence located 1.07 metres from the water's edge, continuing along the east property line for a distance of approximately 2.33 metres and terminating at the south property line in the rear yard of the property known municipally in 2006 as 29 Bessborough Drive, may be retained despite the requirement in § 447-3C(2)(a) that a fence that forms part of a swimming pool enclosure be no closer than 1.2 metres horizontally to the water's edge, provided that when the fence is replaced, it be brought into compliance with the requirements of Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences or its successor by-law.
