BY-LAW No. 67-2006

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths,
Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, respecting bicycle lanes on Strachan Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
 - A. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Strachan Avenue	East, adjacent to curb	Lake Shore Boulevard West and Fleet Street
Strachan Avenue	West, adjacent to curb	Lake Shore Boulevard West and Fleet Street
