BY-LAW No. 73-2006

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Leslie Street and Sheppard Avenue East.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Sheppard Avenue East (M.T. 28)	Between the westerly limit of Leslie Street and a point 30 metres westerly thereof

2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Leslie Street and Sheppard Avenue East (M.T. 61)	Southbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red

3. This By-law shall be in effect from February 1, 2006 to June 30, 2006, inclusive.
