BY-LAW No. 76-2006

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86, respecting maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Leslie Street and Sheppard Avenue East and West.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86, as amended, being a By-law “To prescribe maximum rates of speed on certain Metropolitan Roads”, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Leslie Street (M.T. 60) between Eglinton Avenue and Steeles Avenue	60 kilometres per hour

Sheppard Avenue (M.T. 28) between Weston Road and Kingston Road	60 kilometres per hour

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Leslie Street (M.T. 61) between Lesmill Road and Clovercrest Road	40 kilometres per hour
Leslie Street (M.T. 61) between Clovercrest Road and Steeles Avenue East	60 kilometres per hour
Sheppard Avenue West (M.T. 28) between Weston Road and Yonge Street	60 kilometres per hour
Sheppard Avenue East (M.T. 28) between Yonge Street and Provost Drive/Ambrose Road	60 kilometres per hour
Sheppard Avenue East (M.T. 28) between Provost Drive/Ambrose Road and Buchan Court	40 kilometres per hour

2. This By-law shall be in effect from February 1, 2006 to December 15, 2006, inclusive.
