CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 87-2006

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees, to delete a dishonoured cheque fee for the Municipal Licensing and Standards Division which conflicts with the dishonoured cheque fee for all fees imposed under Chapter 441.

WHEREAS at its meeting of December 7, 2005, City Council enacted By-law No. 1026-2005, which by-law amended City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees, to impose a dishonoured cheque processing fee of \$35.00 for processing cheques returned by reason of insufficient funds used to pay for any fees or charges imposed under that chapter; and

WHEREAS § 441-6E of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees, imposes a fee of \$20.00 for processing cheques returned by reason of insufficient funds used to pay Municipal Licensing and Standards Division fees; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to repeal § 441-6E to give full effect to By-law No. 1026-2005; and

WHEREAS the City Solicitor is authorized under § 169-26A of the Municipal Code Chapter 169, City Officials, to introduce bills if it is necessary to repeal a by-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 441-6E of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees, is repealed.
