BY-LAW No. 155-2006

To layout and dedicate certain land at the rear of premises 35 Scarboro Avenue for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Devonridge Crescent.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with the Chief Planner and Executive Director's Consent Decision B085/05SC respecting land at the rear of premises 35 Scarboro Avenue to form part of the public highway Devonridge Crescent;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land at the rear of the premises 35 Scarboro Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 06204-0274(LT).

Part of Lot 19, Plan 2098 designated as PART 5 on Plan 64R-16671.

City of Toronto (former City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Devonridge Crescent.
