**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 171-2006**

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Eglinton Avenue West, Islington Avenue and Royal York Road.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Eglinton Avenue West and Royal York Road	Eglinton Avenue West and a point 30.5 metres north thereof	Westerly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound right-turning (buses excepted)
Royal York Road and Lawrence Avenue West/The Westway	Lawrence Avenue West/The Westway and a point 30.5 metres north thereof	Westerly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound right-turning (buses excepted)

2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Islington Avenue and the public laneway first north of The Queensway, located on the west side of Islington Avenue (M.T. 63)	Eastbound and Northbound	Left	Anytime
