BY-LAW No. 199-2006

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 880, Fire Routes, to designate
fire routes.**

WHEREAS City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 880, provides for the inclusion of locations in the City of Toronto as designated fire routes where such locations meet the requirements of that Chapter; and

WHEREAS the Fire Chief is satisfied that locations described below meet the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 880, for inclusion of those locations as designated fire routes;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That part or those parts of the private road or roads shown on the site plan filed with the Fire Chief in respect of the municipal addresses set out below in this by-law are designated as fire routes pursuant to Municipal Code Chapter 880, Fire Routes, and Schedule A to Municipal Code Chapter 880 shall be amended by adding the following addresses:
 - (a) 9 and 11 Bergamot Avenue
 - (b) 25 and 27 Bergamot Avenue
 - (c) 5525 and 5535 Eglinton Avenue West
 - (d) 145 Evans Avenue
 - (e) 619 Evans Avenue
 - (f) 6650 Finch Avenue West
 - (g) 95 – 101 Grand Avenue
 - (h) 203 Humber College Boulevard
 - (i) 207 Humber College Boulevard

thereby including those locations as designated fire routes within the meaning of the By-law.
