BY-LAW No. 221-2006

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, respecting Limousines.

WHEREAS Section 150 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* grants local municipalities the authority to license, regulate and govern any business wholly or partly carried on within the municipality for purposes of health and safety, consumer protection and/or nuisance control; and

WHEREAS Planning and Transportation Committee Report 4, Clause 1, was adopted by the City of Toronto Council on May 17, 18 and 19, 2005, authorizing the enactment of By-law No. 706-2005, a by-law amending Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545 by adding Article XXXIX and by requiring limousine service companies to be licensed; and

WHEREAS due to a drafting error By-law No. 706-2005 inadvertently repealed the licence requirement for owners and drivers of limousines;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Section 545-2 of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, is amended by adding the following subsection:
 - (65) Every owner and driver of a limousine.
- 2. This by-law shall be deemed to have come into effect on September 1, 2005.
