CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 291-2006

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Harbord Street, Montrose Avenue and Shaw Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

| (In Column 1) | (In Column 2) | (In Column 3) | (In Column 4) |
|-----------------|---------------|--|---------------|
| Montrose Avenue | West | Harbord Street and a point 15 metres north | Anytime |
| Montrose Avenue | West | Harbord Street and a point 15 metres south | Anytime |
| Shaw Street | West | Harbord Street and a point 15 metres north | Anytime |
| Shaw Street | West | Harbord Street and a point 15 metres south | Anytime |

2. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

| (In Column 1) | (In Column 2) | (In Column 3) | (In Column 4) | (In Column 5) |
|------------------------------------|--|------------------|---------------|------------------------|
| Harbord Street and Montrose Avenue | Montrose Avenue and a point 30 metres east thereof | Centre Westbound | Anytime | Westbound left-turning |
| Harbord Street and Shaw Street | Shaw Street and a point 30 metres east thereof | Centre Westbound | Anytime | Westbound left-turning |
