**BY-LAW No. 437-2006**

**To rename the public highway East Avenue as “Grieves Avenue”.**

WHEREAS notice of the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was posted on the City of Toronto web site from April 27 to May 9, 2006, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 9, 2006, and it is appropriate to rename East Avenue as “Grieves Avenue”;

1. Certain land comprised of the public highway East Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, City Surveyor, as follows, namely:
