CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 440-2006

To dedicate certain land on the east side of Morningside Avenue, south of Casebridge Court, for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Morningside Avenue.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of a one foot reserve acquired in connection with the registration of Plan M-1782; and

WHEREAS the General Manager of Transportation Services has requested that pursuant to Site Plan Application No. 05 195480 ESC 42 SA, part of the one foot reserve along Morningside Avenue be dedicated for public highway purposes for the purposes of legalizing the proposed access to premises 1375 Morningside Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land on the east side of Morningside Avenue, south of Casebridge Court, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PCL RESERVE-1 SECT M1782 PT BLK R BEING A 1' RES 66M1782 LYING N. OF PT 1 66R12787 SCARBOROUGH

City of Toronto (former City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario
Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66)

is dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Morningside Avenue.
