BY-LAW No. 472-2006

To authorize the alteration of Arlington Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and Tyrrel Avenue, by the installation of five speed humps.

WHEREAS a speed hump poll of households on Arlington Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and Tyrrel Avenue, was conducted and the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy. Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of five speed humps on Arlington Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The construction of five speed humps on Arlington Avenue, between St. Clair Avenue West and Tyrrel Avenue, generally as shown on Drawing No. 421F-7747 dated January 2005, on file in the Traffic Operations, Toronto and East York District Office, West Area.
