BY-LAW No. 491-2006

To repeal a portion of By-law No. 396-2006, being a by-law “To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Argyle Street, Carlaw Avenue, Hanna Avenue, King Street West, Musgrave Street, Snooker Street and Wellington Street West.” with respect to Hanna Avenue and Snooker Street.

WHEREAS it is necessary to repeal the references to Hanna Avenue and Snooker Street in the title of By-law No. 396-2006 and to repeal those portions of that By-law relating to those streets; and

WHEREAS through inadvertence a portion of By-law No. 396-2006 was enacted by Council on May 25, 2006, without posting the required notice with respect to the proposed renaming of a portion of Hanna Avenue as Snooker Street; and

WHEREAS in order to provide affected parties with an opportunity to be heard at a meeting of the Toronto and East York Community Council, the public notice will be posted on the City’s website and, if approved by Council, a renaming By-law will be enacted in accordance with *Municipal Act, 2001* requirements; and

WHEREAS the City Solicitor is authorized under Section 169-26A of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 169, City Officials, to introduce bills if it is necessary to repeal a By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The references in the Authority of By-law No. 396-2006, are amended by repealing the reference to “Clause 38” of Toronto and East York Community Council Report 4.
2. The title of By-law No. 396-2006 is amended by repealing the references to “Hanna Avenue” and “Snooker Street”.
3. By-law No. 396-2006 is amended by repealing Section 1A.
