CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 529-2006

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Avenue Road and Highway 401 Eastbound Off-Ramp.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VI (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Avenue Road	Between a point 30.5 metres south of the south curb line of the Highway 401 eastbound off-ramp and a point 30.5 metres north of the north curb line of the Highway 401 eastbound off-ramp

2. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Avenue Road and the Highway 401 eastbound off-ramp	The westerly limit of Avenue Road and a point 30 metres west thereof	Southerly Eastbound and Centre Eastbound	Anytime	Eastbound right-turning
Avenue Road and the Highway 401 eastbound off-ramp	The westerly limit of Avenue Road and a point 30 metres west thereof	Northerly Eastbound	Anytime	Eastbound right-turning (buses excepted)
Avenue Road and Wilson Avenue	The northerly limit of Wilson Avenue and a point 30 metres north	Westerly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound right-turning
