BY-LAW No. 531-2006

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths,
Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, respecting bicycle lanes on Cosburn Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A. By deleting in alphabetical order from the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)
Cosburn Avenue	South, adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Coxwell Avenue and Woodbine Avenue

B. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Cosburn Avenue	South, adjacent to the curb	Coxwell Avenue and Fairside Avenue
Cosburn Avenue	South, adjacent to the curb lane used for parking	Fairside Avenue and Woodbine Avenue
