**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 572-2006**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,  
respecting Renfrew Place.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule I (One-Way Highways) in § 400-54, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Renfrew Place	John Street and St. Patricks Market	Anytime	Westbound

B. By deleting from Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Renfrew Place	Both	Entire length	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in § 400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Renfrew Place	Both	St. Patricks Market and the easterly terminus of Renfrew Place	Anytime

D. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (No Stopping) in § 400-77, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Renfrew Place	Both	John Street and St. Patricks Market	Anytime
