BY-LAW No. 673-2006

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, regarding Keele Street and York Boulevard.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Keele Street and York Boulevard	Keele Street and a point 30.5 metres west	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime	Eastbound right-turning (buses excepted)
Keele Street and York Boulevard	York Boulevard and a point 30.5 metres north	Westerly Southbound	Anytime	Southbound right-turning (buses excepted)
